MATERIAL HANDLING

SURFACE PREPARATION

First locate the leak - check for evidence of damage or tears in the waterproofing. Blistering, open joints and loose wall flashings are also common points of water ingress. In addition to this, leaks maybe detected around chimneys, drainage channels, roof lights and service penetrations.

APPLICATION

Immediately apply IKOpro Emergency Roof Repair to the problem area using a filling knife or trowel, pressing firmly into place. Leave the IKOpro Emergency Roof Repair exposed to the elements so that the curing process can take place satisfactorily.

Upon further inspection of the roof areas during clement weather conditions, should it become apparent that the leaks are attributable to ageing roof materials it is recommended that a longer term solution is undertaken using one of the quality membranes or roof repair products offered by IKO.

Should the leaks be attributable to failing roof construction or poor design, the advice of a suitably qualified professional is advisable.

CLEANING

Tools can be cleaned with white spirit.
