



## 7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Store under cover away from sources of heat and ignition.

## 8. EXPOSURE CONTROLS/PERSONAL PROTECTION

**Hand/skin Protection:** Wear suitable protective gloves and use barrier creams to protect against skin irritation. After completion of the work, thoroughly clean skin with a cleansing cream followed by soap and water.

**Precautionary Measures:** Keep away from all sources of ignition. Do not smoke. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

**Respiratory and Eye Protection:** None normally required. Wear approved respiratory protective equipment and safety glasses with side shields, or use local exhaust ventilation, if glass fibre exposure levels are above the occupational exposure limits.
